This bulletin is not meant to be an all-inclusive list of scholarship information. It only contains information on scholarships that we have actually received at the school. It often does not contain college/university specific scholarships, unless it is a college/university scholarship that requires a specific nomination from Leesville. Students are encouraged to look at the websites for the colleges to which they are applying for specific scholarship information.

1. **Achievement Scholarship for Refugees and Immigrants**- This scholarship will provided financial awards for refugee and immigrant high school seniors. Scholarships will range from \$1000 to \$4000. Applications can be found at: <http://triangle.org/schlarships-awards/>. The deadline to apply is March 31.
2. **North Carolina Alpha Delta Kappa Scholarships**-This sorority is offering 3 scholarships to graduating seniors who are plan to enroll in a 4 year college or university. One of the scholarships is specific to students planning to major in the area of fine arts. Applications are in the Student Services Office. The deadline to apply is March 1.
3. **Young Woman of Achievement Award**-This award, sponsored by the Woman's Club of Raleigh is in the amount of \$1000 and is available to graduating female seniors. Applications are in the Student Services Office and the deadline to apply is February 17.
4. **Assistance League of the Triangle Scholarship**- This scholarship is open to any senior planning to attend college. Applications can be found here: <http://altriangle.org/philanthropic-programs/scholarship/>. The deadline to apply is March 1.
5. **North Carolina Central University Alumni Scholarship**-This scholarship is open to any senior with at least a 3.0 GPA who is planning to attend NCCU. Applications are in the Student Services Office and the deadline to apply is March 15.
6. **Capital Area Bowling Scholarship**-This scholarship is open to any senior who has at least a 2.5 GPA and is a member, or whose parent is a member of the Capital Area USBC. Applications can be found at: www.raleighbowling.com. The deadline to apply is March 3.
7. **WCPSS Future Teachers Program** -The Future Teachers Program is a recruitment initiative aimed at developing WCPSS internal student talent. Future Teachers participants are WCPSS high school graduates who intend to pursue careers in education and who commit to teaching with WCPSS for a minimum of 3 years upon completion of their teacher preparation program.* Annual summer professional development with stipends, beginning the summer following the freshman year of college. *A WCPSS job offer for teaching position for which they are licensed and highly qualified. *The opportunity to develop a professional network with WCPSS staff and peers.

Requirements: Must be a WCPSS high school senior, gain admittance to a college or university for fall 2017 semester and intend to pursue a career in K-12 teaching with WCPSS.

IMPORTANT SENIOR UPDATES !

UPDATED GPA AND RANK

- ✓ Updated GPA and Rank will be available on Thursday, February 9. Please do not request a new transcript before this date.

MIDYEAR TRANSCRIPTS

- ✓ **First of all, most colleges do not require or ask for an updated transcript, However...**
- ✓ If you need a midyear transcript sent to a college or university in North Carolina, that does NOT use the Common Application Program, you will need to complete a Release of Information Form in the Student Services Office. If you are under 18, you will have to take it home, have your parents sign the form and bring it back.
- ✓ CFNC does not update transcripts at the midyear (one that includes your first semester grades and new class rank). This is why the transcript must be sent from our office.
- ✓ If you have already completed a Release of Information Form this year, come to Student Services and ask to add a midyear transcript request to the already completed form.
- ✓ If the college or university is asking for a midyear transcript and uses the Common Application Program. You must email your assigned counselor to let them know.
- ✓ Many colleges and universities ask that you self-report your 1st semester grades. If this is the case, then you would not need to request a transcript.
- ✓ If the college or university needs an updated transcript and is outside of North Carolina, continue to use the SCRIBORDER Website: <https://wcpss.scriborder.com/>

STILL NEED TO APPLY FOR THE FIRST TIME OR HAVE NO DEFINITE PLANS?

- ✓ If you have not yet applied to college or have no definite plans, please email your counselor. They can help direct you in the next steps to take.
