



LRHS Scholarship Bulletin

March 2017

This bulletin is not meant to be an all-inclusive list of scholarship information. It only contains information on scholarships that we have actually received at the school.

1. **State Employees' Credit Union "People Helping People" Scholarship** - This \$10,000 scholarship is open to any senior who meets the following criteria:

- A minimum 2.5 GPA
- Documented acceptance at one of the 16 public universities in North Carolina
- Legal Residency in North Carolina and U.S Citizenship
- An agreement to attend the same public university for eight consecutive semesters
- **Outstanding evidence** of leadership, character, integrity, and community involvement
- Is not an employee or family member of an employee of the State Employees' Credit Union

Leesville's scholarship committee can select one student to receive this award. The student chosen by Leesville will receive the \$10,000 award.

Interested seniors should pick up an application packet and instructions in the Student Services' Office. Requested information should be returned to Student Services by April 3.

2. **Leesville PTSA Scholarships** - The PTSA is offering two \$500 scholarships to Leesville seniors. The criteria for both are listed below:

PTSA Sherry Frost School Involvement Scholarship

- 2.5 or above weighted GPA
- School involvement
- One teacher recommendation
- Completion of an essay (topic is included on the application)

PTSA Academic Scholarship

- 3.7 (or above) weighted GPA
- School and community involvement
- One teacher recommendation
- Completion of an essay (topic is included on the application)

Applications for both scholarships are in the Student Services' Office. Completed materials must be returned to Student Services by **April 3**.

3. **PRIDE Athletic Club, Jeff Sanders Memorial Scholarship**-This scholarship is in memory of Jeff Sanders, a parent of Leesville athletes Sara and Thomas, who also volunteered countless hours to the Leesville athletics program and facilities over many years. Two **\$1000** scholarships will be awarded, one to a male athlete and one to a female athlete.

Scholarship Requirements:

- Have participated in a varsity sport their senior year as a player, manager, trainer, statistician or sports medicine student.
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- Have an exemplary discipline and attendance record
- Planning to attend some form of higher education
- Recommendation from the coach of your sport

Applications are in the Student Services Office and are due back to Student Services by **April 3**.

3. **Michelle B. Vitale Memorial Scholarship** – The Michelle B. Vitale Trust is proud to offer an annual scholarship in memory of Michelle B. Vitale, a former teacher at Leesville Road High School. Ms. Vitale dedicated her life to working with children of all ages. The criteria for the \$1000 scholarship are:
 - Plans for further education as a full-time student
 - **Plans to pursue a degree in Education**
 - Current GPA of 3.0 or higher
 - Two letters of recommendation from LRHS Staff membersApplications for this scholarship are in the Student Services' Office. Completed applications with attached letters of recommendation and other requested information should be returned to Student Services by **April 3**.
4. **Dr. James E. Hedrick Memorial Scholarship**-This one time scholarship is offered to high school seniors who have an interest in pursuing a career in education. The application must be completed online at: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/hedrickscholarship2017>. The application will close on April 16. Students will need to complete the entire application at one time as site will not let you save your work and come back to it. Detailed Instructions are available in the Student Services Office.
5. **Hammond Hill Scholarship**-This \$2000 scholarship sponsored by Alpha Delta Kappa is for graduating seniors who plan to enter the field of education. Applications are in the Student Services Office and the deadline to mail your application is April 10.
6. **North Carolina Central University Muriel Brown Memorial Scholarship**- This award is for student planning to attend NCCU with a major in education. Applications can be found at www.nccuraleighwake.org. The deadline to apply is April 16.
7. **Achievement Scholarship for Refugees and Immigrants of Wake County** provides financial awards for refugee and immigrant high school seniors who reside in Wake County to continue their education in a post-secondary setting. The amount awarded per recipient can vary between \$1,000 and \$4,000 per academic year, and is renewable for up to 4 years. Applications are due March 31. 8. **NC Society of Accountants Scholarship** - This \$750 scholarship is for any senior planning to study accounting in college. Applications and Instructions are in the Student Services' Office. The deadline to apply is April 15.
9. **State Employees Association of North Carolina Scholarship**- Each year, SEANC, offers academic scholarships to the children of SEANC members. For information and an application, go to: <http://www.seanc.org/membership/scholarship/>. The deadline to apply is April 15.
10. **Phebe Harlan Emmons Grant**-This \$1000 scholarship sponsored by the Gamma Eta Chapter of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society is for senior females who plan to major in education. Academic achievement, character and commitment to further education will also be considered. Applications are in Student Services and the deadline to apply is April 7.
11. **Better Business Bureau Torch Scholarships**-This scholarships recognizes students who personify high ethics as demonstrated through leadership, community service, personal integrity and academic excellence. Applications can be found at: www.bbbscholarship.org. The deadline to apply is March 3.
12. **Light on the Hill Scholarship**-This scholarship is open to African-American students who plan to attend UNC-Chapel Hill. Information and the application can be found at www.alumni.unc.edu/loth. The deadline to apply is March 31.
13. **Raleigh Optimist Club Scholarship**-Two scholarship are being offered by the Raleigh Optimist Club for graduating seniors who are planning to continue their education after high school. Applications can be found at: www.raleigh-optimist.org. Applications must be postmarked by March 28.
