- 1. Raleigh Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship-The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants. Any high school senior who is a U.S. citizen may apply. Go to <a href="https://www.elks.org/enf/scholars">www.elks.org/enf/scholars</a> for more information and to apply online. The deadline to apply is November 30.
- 2. **Sallie Southall Cotton Scholarship**-This scholarship is open to any senior who will be attending a four-year college in North Carolina. It is based on Academics, Leadership, Personal Character and Financial need. The deadline to apply is December 15.
- 3. Stephen J. Brady STOP Hunger Scholarship-This scholarship is for students who have demonstrated ongoing commitment to their community by performing unpaid volunteer services impacting hunger. - 4. **Burger King Scholars**-This scholarship is open to high school seniors and employees of Burger King who plan to further their education. Criteria include high academic standards, leadership potential, public service and interest in diversity of people and cultures in and outside USA. ## 7. AXA ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Award is given to seniors who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in school, community or workplace. Applicants must be US citizens or legal resident and plan to enroll full time at a two
