



# LRHS Scholarship Bulletin

## Bulletin #1 2014-2015

This bulletin will be distributed to all seniors who have a second period class periodically throughout school year. It is not meant to be an all inclusive list of scholarship information. It only contains information on scholarships that we have actually received at the school. It often does not contain college/university specific scholarships, unless it is a college/university scholarship that requires a specific nomination from Leesville. Students are encouraged to look at the websites for the colleges to which they are applying for specific scholarship information.

All three of the scholarships listed require a school nomination. Please follow the directions for each scholarship.

1. **UNC Morehead-Cain Scholarship-** This Scholarship is a full four-year undergraduate merit scholarship to UNC. This award established in 1951 also offers summer opportunities for the approximate 75 students who receive it each year. Morehead nominees must demonstrate all of the following criteria:
  - **Leadership-**Students should possess the capacity to lead and motivate fellow students.
  - **Scholarship-**Student should have a high scholastic ability and extracurricular attainments.
  - **Character-**Morals and values should direct the student's path.
  - **Physical vigor-**Involvement in an organized school or community sport.

Teachers are currently submitting names for consideration for this scholarship, but you may also self-nominate for the scholarship as well. If you would like to apply for the Morehead, come to the Student Services Office and pick up an application. Applications are due back to Student Services by **the close of the school day on September 15.**

2. **NC State Park Scholarship-**This scholarship was established in 1996 and this year will award approximately 45 four-year full expense scholarships. The criteria for the scholarship are:
  - **Scholarship-**Student has a high record of academic achievement; displays a desire to learn; takes the most challenging courses.
  - **Leadership-** Student has demonstrated leadership in and out of school; takes risks and champions new, original ideas; sets a good example for others
  - **Service-** Student shows concern for others by identifying their needs and working to meet them
  - **Character-** Student has integrity, is honest and conscientious; is resilient when faced with diversity.

Teachers are currently submitting names for consideration for this scholarship, but you may also self-nominate for the scholarship as well. If you would like to apply for the Park, come to the Student Services Office and pick up an application. Applications are due back to Student Services by **the close of the school day on September 15.**

3. **Davidson College-Bryan Scholars Program-** The Bryan Scholarship program offers awards, each valued at \$30,000 annually, to two scholar-athletes (one man and one woman). Candidates are chosen on the basis of: academic and personal excellence, strong promise of significant impact in their classes and in their lives on campus, potential for significant success in Davidson's NCAA Division I athletic program.
